

CASA Emancipating Youth Grants

Philanthropic Ventures Foundation

What: Grants of up to \$250 will be awarded to Court Appointed Special Advocates to help meet the critical needs of foster care youth as they age out of the Dependency system. Examples include funding for college application fees, work clothing, vocational tool, tutoring, etc.

Who: Any Court Appointed Special Advocate working with foster care youth in Alameda, Contra Costa, San Francisco, San Mateo, and Santa Clare Counties, is eligible to apply for a maximum of two grants in a one-year period, one per client.

How: We have made it easy! Simply send your request to PVF by facsimile on CASA letterhead including the following information:

- Date and Notation that application is for a “CASA Emancipating Youth Grant”
- Your Name, Title, Address, Telephone, Fax and Email address
- Description of youth’s need, reason requesting funding and how this will assist youth as he/she ages out of the system
- Total Amount Requested and detail of how money will be spent itemizing unit prices; checks are made payable to the CASA volunteer to oversee, or to a vendor (if paid to a vendor, please provide names of payee, and address; check will be mailed to the CASA)
- Application must have signature approval of your supervisor

Deadline: Send your request by facsimile as soon as it is ready- money is limited. Funding will be immediately available, if approved.
